

**SENIOR ADVISORY COMMITTEE**  
**Minutes of Regular Meeting**

**Wednesday, February 16, 2022**

1. A regular meeting of the La Verne Senior Advisory Committee was called to order at 10:00 AM on Wednesday, February 16, 2022.

Members present: Terry Kistler, George Borst, Lorraine Missick, Jenny Jolly, Bette Donovan and Scott Snider.

Members absent: None.

Staff Present: Yvonne Duran, Community Services Manager and Amanda Triay, Community Services Specialist.

Guests present: None.

It was moved and seconded to approve the minutes of the Wednesday, November 17, 2021 meeting. Motion carried.

Unfinished Business

2. Senior Nutrition Program: For the Grab-n-Go meals, there were an average of 81 meals distributed per week in November 2021, an average of 77 meals distributed per week in December 2021, and an average of 82 meals distributed per week in January 2022.
3. Guest Speaker: None.
4. Bingo Report: There were a total of 48 in attendance at the first session back together. All bills are paid for paper and new table covers are to be ordered. The issue of finding new callers has been resolved, as new applications have been turned in. The current Bingo balance is \$3,780.35.
5. Meals on Wheels: 730 meals were served to 38 La Verne recipients in November 2021, 795 meals were served to 41 La Verne recipients in December 2021, and 400 meals were served to 44 La Verne recipients in January 2022. for an average of 48 meals per day. A total of 1,008 meals were distributed in San Dimas and La Verne combined.
6. Account Balance: \$4,141.49
7. Senior Program Fees: All fees have been paid for November and December 2021. Garden Friends may no longer be meeting at the Community Center..

8. MT. SAC Classes: Spring classes begin the week of February 21, 2022.
9. Aging Next: 8 meals were delivered and 28 individuals were provided with case management in November 2021. 16 meals were delivered and 34 individuals were provided with case management in December 2021. 20 meals were delivered and 32 individuals were provided with case management in January 2022. An upcoming meeting will be held at the Community Center.

11. Facilities Report: During the January windstorms a tree fell in front of Veterans Hall but all cleanup has been completed. The Weber House was also hit by fallen trees, causing damage to some fencing. These repairs are still being worked on.
12. Public Comments: Yvonne mentioned the City of La Verne has a new Fire Chief and new Police Chief. She also noted that in the event of a City emergency, residents should call City Hall for help. Additionally, she shared that Francis, a longtime volunteer, passed away at 101 years old. A Memorial Service will be held on Saturday, March 5<sup>th</sup>, at 9:00 AM. There will not be a City Council Meeting held on March 22<sup>nd</sup>; information on this can be found in the Community News Letter. It was also noted that there has been a lot of positive feedback in regards to the Recreation Guide now being mailed out to households in La Verne. Paulina will be leaving but will continue to work for the city part time. Robyn Olsen is now at the Front Desk and Ricardo Aguilar has obtained the position of part-time Recreation Specialist. All positions for the Community Center have now been filled.

Scott gave an update on Hillcrest. They are starting to open up more; however, Assisted Living is not able to mingle with others yet. Their art display is now back as well.

George gave an update on Golf. The group is currently averaging 20 players. He also shared that 60 trees came down at Marshall Canyon during the wind storm.

Lastly, Lorraine mentioned that the San Dimas Center is having monthly dinners.
