

SENIOR ADVISORY COMMITTEE
Minutes of Regular Meeting

Wednesday, April 20, 2022

1. A regular meeting of the La Verne Senior Advisory Committee was called to order at 10:00 AM on Wednesday, April 20, 2022.

Members present: Terry Kistler, George Borst, Lorraine Missick, Bette Donovan and Scott Snider.

Members absent: Jenny Jolly.

Staff Present: Yvonne Duran, Community Services Manager and Amanda Triay, Community Services Specialist.

Guests present: Shawn Igoe, Public Works Director.

It was moved and seconded to approve the minutes of the Wednesday, February 16, 2022 meeting. Motion carried.

Unfinished Business

2. Senior Nutrition Program: For the Grab-n-Go meals, there was an average of 103 participants per week in February and an average of 119 meals distributed per week in March. The La Verne Community Center kitchen was inspected as a requirement for resuming congregate meals later this year. A leak was discovered and fixed; everything else is okay. A site manager and volunteers are needed to resume meals in late August or September. Upon opening, there will be a vaccination requirement. Volunteers will need to be vaccinated against Covid-19 and a flu shot will be required as well.
3. Guest Speaker: Shawn Igoe, Public Works Director.
Shawn provided information regarding the responsibilities of the Public Works Department. He also advised that White Street will reopen when the LA County Fair starts.
4. Bingo Report: There was an average of 42 players in February and March. Attendance on Good Friday was down so it has been taken into consideration to cancel Bingo on Good Friday 2023. New table covers were purchased for \$200 and paper stock has been replenished. Additionally, payments were made to Bingo West in the amounts of \$443.00 in February and \$532 in March. The Bingo display is currently having problems. The current Bingo balance is \$2,774.35.
5. Meals on Wheels: 766 meals were served to 50 La Verne recipients in February 2022 and 865 meals were served to 47 La Verne recipients in March.

6. Account Balance: \$4,731.00
7. Senior Program Fees: All fees have been paid with the exception of Garden Friends.
8. MT. SAC Classes: Summer classes begin in June and will run through August. In person Request to Register will be held on May 9th. Online Request to Register is also available May 1st through May 27th.
9. Aging Next: 19 La Verne residents received case management in February and 42 La Verne residents received case management in March. Aging next will be asked to be a guest speaker at the next S.A.C. meeting.

12. Older Americans Month: Yvonne announced the City Council will be recognizing the Older Americans at the May 16th Council meeting. All S.A.C. members are invited to attend.
13. Public Comments: Scott provided updates on Hillcrest and shared that the dining room needs to be remodeled. Yvonne announced a new website for the City will launch on April 28th. Accounts can be created to receive updates, etc. There will also be a page for senior programs. Amanda discussed new excursions that will be coming up in June, July and August. George provided an update on Senior Golf. The league continues to have an average of 20 players participate. A date will be set in May for the SAC luncheon, which is normally held in December.
