Christmas Tree Recycling

It's that time of year again...carols and lights, tinsel and hot chocolate. Along with the bright joys of the season, comes a darker side...a lot of extra materials in our landfills. From the millions of holiday cards, to the packaging and wrapping paper from gifts, we will see tremendous amounts of trash in our carts. To help prevent some of this from ending up in the landfills, the City of La Verne in conjunction with Waste Management is once again offering Christmas Tree Recycling. We ask that you remove the stand, water container, tinsel and other decorations before placing your tree curbside on the three Mondays following Christmas, December 28th, January 4th or 11th. Trees can be picked up on later dates, when requested as a large item pickup. If your tree is over six feet, we kindly request that you cut it in half. Flocked trees are accepted, but **CANNOT** be recycled due to the chemicals in the flocking material.
