SB 1383 Update-PAILS FOR ORGANICS RECYCLING

As the New Year begins, and Californians start implementing SB 1383, the “Organics Law”, the City of La Verne has purchased pails to help our residents recycle organic matter the kitchen more easily. Our 1.9 gallon pails are built for convenience:

- Made with lightweight material;
- A vented lid to help moisture evaporate, reducing odor causing bacteria;
- Dishwasher safe (no heat) for easy cleaning;
- Latch to reduce accidental opening, if dropped;
- Easy and strategic grips for ease of carrying and emptying;
- A wide opening to allow for scraping from large plates;
- Small size to fit on the counter under cabinets or in a large drawer.
