Does not apply to properly maintained drip irrigation systems, hand watering of trees & established Very High Fire Hazard Safety Zone areas (VHFHSZ).

Watering permitted between the hours of 6:00 PM and 10:00 AM

No more than eight minutes per station or area, and not to exceed more than eight minutes per week.

Established VHFHSZ are to reduce water usage by 20% of their 2020 usage.

The following restrictions are now in place;

- Even addresses ok to water on Tuesdays (addresses ending in 0, 2, 4, 6, 8) for no more than 8 minutes per station or area. *Does not apply to properly maintained drip irrigation systems, hand watering of trees and established Very High Fire Hazard Safety Zone areas.
- Odd addresses are ok to water on Thursdays (addresses ending in 1, 3, 5, 7, 9) for no more than 8 minutes per station or area. *Does not apply to properly maintained drip irrigation systems, hand watering of trees and established Very High Fire Hazard Safety Zone areas.
- Residents are allowed to water between the hours of **6:00PM – 10:00AM**
- Hose washing of sidewalks, walkways, driveways, parking areas, hardscapes, or other paved surfaces shall be prohibited.
- Washing of motor vehicles, trailers, boats, and other types of mobile equipment's shall be done only with a hand-held water container or a hose equipped with a positive shut off nozzle for quick rinses, except that washing may be done on the immediate premises of a commercial car wash or with reclaimed water.
- No water shall be used to clean, fill or maintain levels in decorative fountains, or other similar aesthetic structures unless such water is part of a recycling system.
- Watering in a manner that causes runoff from landscaped areas into adjoining streets, sidewalks, or other paved areas, or watering within forty-eight hours after measurable precipitation shall be prohibited.
- All leaks from indoor and outdoor plumbing fixtures shall be repaired within forty-eight hours of discovery or notification.
