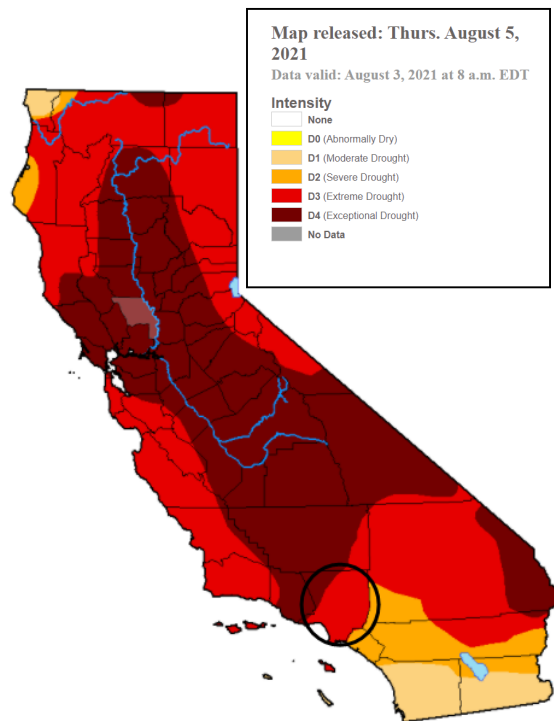
Executive Order

With California rainfall is at historic lows resulting in another dry year, Governor Gavin Newsom issued an Executive Order (N-10-21) on July 8, 2021, calling on all Californians to voluntarily reduce their water use by 15 percent from their 2020 levels. The State Water Resources Control Board (Water Board) will begin tracking and reporting monthly on the State's progress toward achieving a 15-percent reduction in statewide urban water use as compared to 2020 use.

Assist the City in Meeting the Governor's Mandate to Reduce Water Use by 15%

The following Stage 1 Water Supply Emergency use restrictions and conservation practices are currently in place.

- No Watering Between 9am-5pm
- Watering is Restricted to 3 Days/Week
- Wait 48 Hours After Rainfall to Water
- Don't Let Water Runoff Into the Street or Sidewalk
- Avoid Washing Down Driveways and Sidewalks
- Decorative Water Fountains Must Use Re-circulating Systems
- Repair Indoor and outdoor Water Leaks Quickly
- Use Hoses with Shut-off Nozzles to Wash Cars
- Restaurants Can Serve Water Upon Request
- Don't Choose Daily Laundry Service at Hotels
